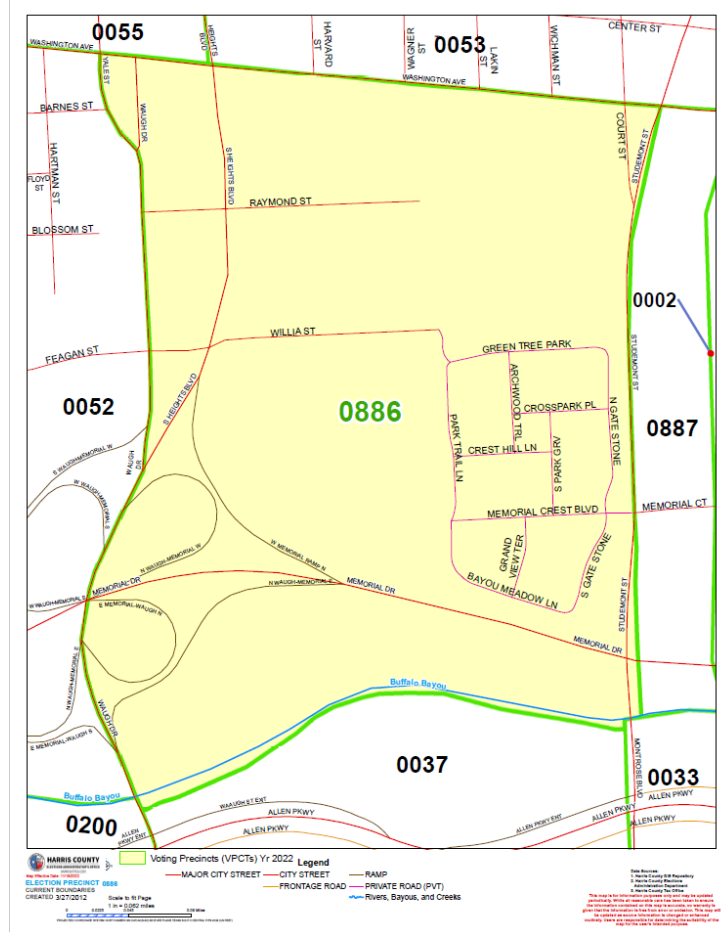
What is a Precinct Chair?

A precinct is the smallest political subdivision. The office of Precinct Chair is one of the most important positions in the entire Democratic Party. A Precinct Chair is a Democratic Party Official at the LOCAL level elected by Democratic voters to serve as the party leader of their precinct.

Precinct Chairs also sit on the County Executive Committee (CEC), which conducts the local business of the Party. The duties of Precinct Chairs provide fundamental services to party effectiveness.

Precinct Chair Qualifications:

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Be a qualified voter who has voted in the latest Democratic primary (not counting runoffs) in the voting year. (If not, a Democratic OATH may be signed and the Vacancy Committee may decide)
- Be a resident of the precinct from which he or she is seeking election (see map below)
- Not be a candidate for - or holder of - an elective office of the federal, state, or county government
- Ideally, have both Internet, e-mail capabilities and basic computer skills
